

The 2021/22 Michael Gordon Journalism Fellowships

The Michael Gordon Journalism Fellowships is a national program to enable social justice journalism. The program was created in honour of the much respected former Age political editor, who died suddenly in February 2018.

Grants totalling up to \$30,000 will fund reporting projects in areas including Indigenous affairs, migration policy, human rights and international development.



The Fellowships are supported by:





- Individual grants of up to \$10,000 available for projects
- The program is open to all journalists, photographers and videographers with mainstream Australian news organisations, freelance journalists and accomplished journalism students. We encourage applications across all media.
- Applicants submit a project proposal addressing the selection criteria and provide a budget for their project. Applicants will be asked to submit a statement about how their research project will be achieved, pending ongoing Covid travel restrictions and border closures.
