Tia Kass is an illustrator whose art for a *Saturday Paper* story on migrant workers was recognised with the 2020 *Artwork and Reporting on Multicultural Affairs* Quill Awards. Praised by judges for the richness and detail of his work, his work is expressive, media-rich, and shows how powerful illustrations can be in storytelling.
